The council meets the 2nd Monday of every month at 6 p.m. The building permits are good for one year from date of approval from the city council.

RELATIONSHIP TO VETERAN: Mother, Daughter, Sister,

Grandmother, Granddaughter

Self-Female, Veterans who have served, Male or Female Spouse.

ELIGIBILITY PERIODS: April 6, 1917, to November 11, 1918; and any time after December 7, 1941.

TWO PATHS FOR ALA ELIGIBILTY:

<u>Path one:</u> The potential member is related to a living veteran by one of the relationships stated (**Under Relationship to Veteran**) the veteran is living AND a current member of The American Legion.

If the potential member is a female veteran, she only needs to have served during the eligible time periods to be eligible for ALA membership.

<u>Path Two:</u> The potential member is related to a deceased veteran who served during the eligible time periods and was honorably discharged. The deceased veteran did not have to be a member of the American Legion in order for the potential member to join the ALA.

Dear City Resident:

It has been brought to the city council's attention that there is an issue of dogs running at large throughout the City of Wood Lake. If you are not a dog owner, this will not apply to you. If you are a dog owner, then we expect you to abide by the city dog ordinance which we've included in this letter and that your dog/dogs will be either confined by fencing or leash of some type on your property at all times. It is getting to be a nuisance with dogs running at large and the risk of residents getting bitten by these dogs. There have been incidents of this actually happening, and we don't want to see it happen again. This is a portion of the Ordinance #12 that is in place.

Subd.2. Running at Large Prohibited. It is unlawful for the owner of any animal to permit such animal to run at large. Any dog shall be deemed to be running at large with the permission of the owner unless it is on a durable leash secured to an object which it cannot move and on the premises of the owner, or on a leash or under the control of an accompanying person of suitable age discretion, or effectively confined within a motor vehicle, building, or enclosure. Any cat shall be deemed to be running at large with the permission of the owner unless it is on the premises of the owner, or effectively confined with a motor vehicle, building, or enclosure.

The city would appreciate your cooperation in following the city's ordinance and that as a dog owner you would be respectful of your neighbors and other city residents in following the rules put in place by the city.
