

**WOOD LAKE PUBLIC HEARING ON CITY OF WOOD LAKE TOBACCO RETAILER
ORDINANCE**

MONDAY, AUGUST 14, 2023 at 5:30 P.M.—COMMUNITY CENTER SMALL ROOM

Council members Mayor David Stelter, Wayne Tonn, Tammi Mueller, Brad Timm, and Sean Brovold, along with the City Clerk, Ashley VanHecke, were present.

The Public Hearing was called to order by Mayor, David Stelter at 5:30 p.m.

No residents or retailers were present for the Public Hearing. No statements or comments were submitted for the Open Forum.

There being no statements or comments, the Open Forum was closed at 5:45 p.m. and the city council held a formal vote. A motion was made by Timm and seconded by Mueller to adopt the Yellow Medicine County Tobacco Ordinance. Motion passed with all in favor. All members voted in favor to repeal the existing City of Wood Lake Tobacco Ordinance, Chapter 1, Section 7.30, Subd. 3, all parts and adopt the Yellow Medicine County Tobacco Ordinance.

The repeal will be effective 1 January, 2024 for tobacco retailers in the City of Wood Lake.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Timm and seconded by Mueller to adjourn the Public Hearing. Motion passed with all in favor. Mayor Stelter adjourned the Public Hearing at 5:50 p.m.
