

WOOD LAKE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE VACATION OF AN ALLEY PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTE § 412.851

The Public Hearing was called to order by Acting Mayor, Tammi Mueller at 6:00 p.m.

No residents or visitors were present for the Public Hearing. No statements or comments were submitted for the Open Forum.

Written notice will be provided to the property owners that vacation is hereby granted, along with a copy of the executed **RESOLUTION NO. 2023-0911A**.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Mueller and seconded by Brovold to adjourn the Public Hearing. Motion passed with all in favor. Mayor, David Stelter, adjourned the Public Hearing at 6:15 p.m.
