

SPECIAL MEETING TO CONDUCT INTERVIEWS FOR PART-TIME SUMMER HELP FOR CITY MAINTENANCE AND OTHER CITY BUSINESS.  
MONDAY, MAY 17, 2021 AT 6:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stelter at 6:05 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance

Members present were: Mayor Stelter, council members: Mueller, Timm, and Brovold, and city Clerk Drager. Himley was absent. Visitors: Kallie Breitbarth, Kristian Louwagie, and Donald Quasdorf.

Each of the candidates were interviewed by Brad Timm with council and city clerk present and the other candidates waited in the reception area of the Community Center during the interview process. The candidates were asked questions concerning what the job would entail and if any of them were familiar with lawn equipment, chemicals, and any other equipment to be used with maintenance of the parks and city property. The other council members were given a chance to ask any other questions and the candidates also for the council. The candidates were then able to leave the interview process around 7:15 p.m. At 7:20 the council called Allen Chrisman to come to the meeting to answer questions the council had about the job.

A motion by Timm and seconded by Mueller to approve a building permit to Sean Brovold for fencing in his yard. Brovold abstained from voting and the mayor concurred.


City clerk brought up that Andrew VanHecke has been charged for a 65-gallon garbage container for over 5 years and only has been using a 35-gallon one. She would like to give him the credit for this overcharge. She will also be submitting a credit to Olson Sanitation for the difference as we have been overpaying them also. The council was in favor of this credit to the VanHeckes.

The council questioned Al on some concerns they had with the position and were satisfied with his answers. Al left the meeting when finished with the questioning.

A motion by Brovold and seconded by Mueller to hire Kallie Breitbarth for the part time summer help. Motion passed with all in favor and Mayor Stelter concurred. Clerk was instructed to contact the candidates tonight after the meeting whether hired or not.

As this concluded the business for which this meeting was called, a motion by Timm and seconded by Brovold was made to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed with all in favor.
