ITEMS THAT WILL BE COLLECTED:

- *Furniture (couches, chairs, recliners, bookshelves, file cabinets, tables)
- *Cabinets

- *Painted or Wood Treated Items
- *Carpet or Carpet Pads
- *Railroad Ties must be 3' or less *Windows, Doors, Plywood
- *Sheet Rock, Press Board, Paneling (construction materials that are treated or glued) *NO PIANOS
