NOTICE-CITY DUMP SITE

Garage & Lumber are strictly prohibited from the city dump!

“No lumber of any kind allowed”

Allowed items:

Compost: Leaves, grass, garden waste

Burn pile: Tree branches and logs only

Regulations are set by the DNR

If this continues to be abused, the city dump will be locked and opened only by maintenance.

LAWN/GRASS MAINTENANCE – see ordinance below:
SEC. 7.13. MAINTENANCE OF PRIVATE PROPERTY.

Subd. 1. It is the primary responsibility of any owner or occupant of any lot or parcel of land to maintain any weeds or grass growing thereon at a height of not more than six inches. To remove all public health or safety hazards therefrom. To install or repair water service line thereon. And to treat or remove insect-infested or diseased trees thereon.

Subd. 2. If any such owner or occupant fails to assume the primary responsibility described in Subdivision 1 of the Section, and after notice given by the City Clerk-Treasurer shall certify to the City. Such amount together with interest shall be entered as a special assessment against such lot or parcel of land and be collected in the same manner as real estate taxes.

It is also not allowed to dispose of sticks/branches on the boulevard or to blow grass trimmings into the street.
