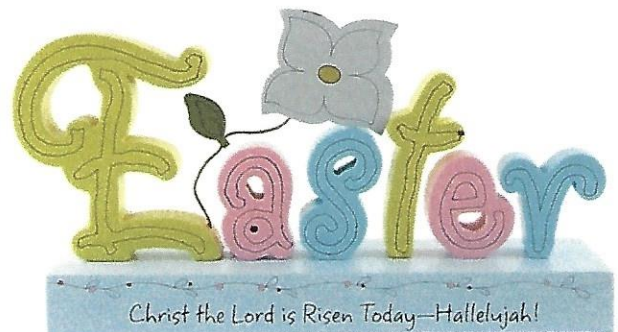

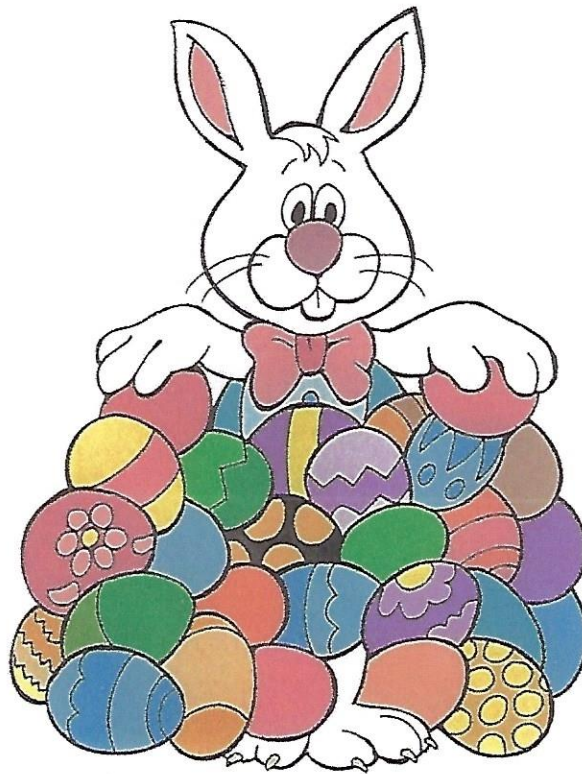

**ITEMS THAT WILL BE COLLECTED:**

- \*Furniture (couches, chairs, recliners, bookshelves, file cabinets, tables)
- \*Cabinets \*Painted or Wood Treated Items
- \*Carpet or Carpet Pads
- \*Railroad Ties - must be 3' or less \*Windows, Doors, Plywood
- \*Sheet Rock, Press Board, Paneling (construction materials that are treated or glued) **\*NO PIANOS**

**Items that need to be paid for in advance:**

**All Appliances, TV's, Mattresses, Box Springs : \$25 ea.**

**These items must be paid for in advance at the City office by Monday, May 10 to be put on the pick-up list. If your name is not on the list, it will not be picked up.**

- \*Water Softeners \*Refrigerators \*Freezers \*Water Heaters \*Dehumidifiers \*Stoves
- \*Washers/Dryers \*Microwaves \*Air Conditioners \*Box Springs \*Mattresses
- \*TV/Computer Monitors \*Water Coolers **\*NO RV REFRIGERATORS**

**ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED:**

- \*Fluorescent Bulbs & Fixtures \*Tires \*Oil/Filters \*Cleaning Supplies \*Paint/Varnish \*Batteries
- \*Petroleum Products \*Stains \*Yard Chemicals \*Concrete \*Pianos
- Please dispose of these items at your local compost site:** \*Shrubs \*Grass Trimmings \*Tree Branches \*Garden Greens \*Compostables

The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether property in the jurisdiction has been properly valued and classified by the assessor.

If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the valuation or classification after discussing it with your assessor, you may appear before the local board of appeal and equalization. The board will review your assessments and may make corrections as needed. Generally, you must appeal to the local board before appealing to the county board of appeal and equalization.

This may be a virtual local board meeting for your township/city or you have a virtual option. Most township/city officials will remain at home to attend the meeting and will be present via your telephone. In some taxing districts, some officials have chosen to be at the original posted location. I will remain in my office, essentially, this meeting is similar to a conference call.

Ten minutes prior to the start of the meeting, please call the telephone number listed below. Enter the access code followed by the # key. It is not necessary to enter the PIN, you will be prompted to enter the # key a second time. This will join you to the meeting. You may also join from your computer, tablet, or smartphone.

All taxpayers have been notified of the log-in information on their Notice of Valuation and Classification. Due to limited space on the notices, the taxpayers were referred to Yellow Medicine County's Website for the log-in information.

This format will provide all of us with a safe environment.
