

To the electors of the City of Wood Lake, Yellow Medicine County, State of Minnesota: Notice is hereby given that a general election will be held in the City of Wood Lake at the Wood Lake Community Center on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 at which time the polls will be open from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. For the purpose of electing candidates for Federal, State, County, Lakeview School Board, and City Offices. Positions on the Wood Lake City Council to be voted on include the Mayor (2 year term) and 2 Council positions (4 year terms). General Display of our Flag

It is the universal custom to display the flag only from sunrise to sunset on buildings and on stationary flagstaffs in the open. However, when a patriotic effect is desired, the flag may be displayed twenty-four hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness.

The flag should be hoisted briskly and lowered ceremoniously.

The flag should not be displayed on days when the weather is inclement, except when an all-weather flag is displayed.

The flag should be displayed daily, on or near the main administration building of every public institution... in or near every polling place on election days...during school days in or near every schoolhouse.

No other flag or pennant should be placed above or, if on the same level, to the right of the flag of the United States of America, except during church services conducted by naval chaplains at sea...for personnel of the Navy...when the church pennant may be flown above the flag.

No person shall display the flag of the United Nations or any other national or international flag equal, above, or in a position of superior prominence or honor to, or in place of, the flag of the United States at any place within the United States or any Territory or possession thereof: Provided, that nothing in this section shall make unlawful the continuance of the practice heretofore followed of displaying the flag of the United Nations in a position of superior prominence or honor, and other national flags in position of equal prominence or honor, with that of the flag of the United States at the headquarters of the United Nations.
